



Entry Permit Required States

Colorado

- A CVI is required for a cat and dog.
- Vaccinations are required for cats and dogs three months or older.
- The transporter needs [an entry permit](#) to be able to bring the animal to the shelter/rescue.
- The shelter/rescue who will be receiving the animal needs to have [an entry permit](#).

Connecticut

- A dog or cat cannot be imported for resale under eight weeks old.
- A dog or cat imported require a Health Certificate issued within 30 days.
 - Certificate must state animal is free from infectious and contagious disease.
 - Certificate must state animal is not from an area under quarantine for rabies.

Maine

- A CVI is required for a cat and dog.
- A vaccination is required for a cat or a dog four months or older.
- For resale or adoption of a dog or a cat, a CVI is required.
- For resale or adoption of a dog or a cat, [an entry permit](#) is required.

Massachusetts

- A dog or cat imported require a Health Certificate issued within 30 days.
- A dog or cat must have a CVI and comply with the [Emergency Order 1-AHO-05](#) which states all persons transporting an animal needs to fill out an [Animal Entity Registration Form](#).
