DO NOT ASSUME ANYTHING

Know what kind of dog you are transporting including their size, behavior.



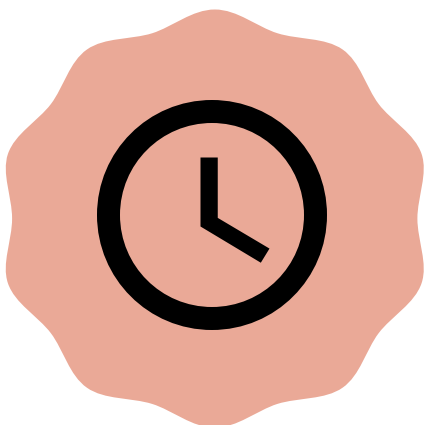
MAKE SURE EVERYONE IS ON THE SAME PAGE

Know the route you signed up for and keep in touch with everyone on the transport



CONSIDER KEEPING A LOG SHEET FOR YOUR TRANSPORT

Keeping a folder with all of the necessary information of the animal can be very helpful (health certificates, feeding schedule, water intake and even a bathroom log).



BE CONSIDERATE OF TIME

Things may take longer than you think and problems may arise. This can include weather, problems with the animal or taking extra stops.



HAVE SUPPLIES ON HAND!

Some things to keep in your vehicle include water, blankets, hand wipes, paper towels, plastic/trash bags and maybe even extra leashes or collars.
